The county will provide new library software, some supplies, and two part-time employees to join our volunteers in keeping the library open 22 hours per week. 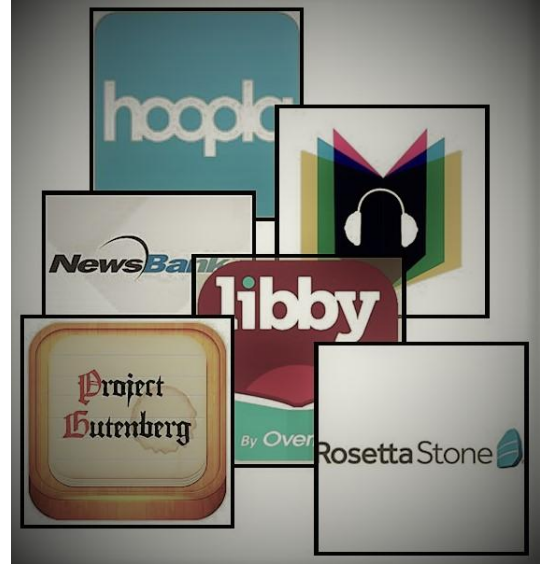
